

A mounted parade, with all competitors properly turned out, shall precede prize giving. Dress and saddlery as for Stadium Jumping.

Coaching: One coach per team is permitted to accompany and instruct prior to Cross Country and Stadium Jumping only. Competitors and coach are permitted to **re-walk** the Cross Country course prior to the competition. Chaperones, Coaches, Parents and Observers please note that any other coaching of competitors during rally will result in penalties being assigned to the competitor or team involved.

Transportation: Each team is responsible for their own transportation to the rally. If a team chooses not to stay on the grounds, the chaperone may have to make two trips to transport an entire team of 7 competitors. Competitors may not drive during rally.

Refunds and substitutions: Any cancellation of the entry after the closing date in case of illness, lameness or other unavoidable circumstances may be partially refunded as long as it is certified by the District Commissioner and accompanied by a doctor's or veterinarian's certificate, if applicable. Substitutions of horse or competitor due to unavoidable circumstances, may be granted pending immediate application to the organizing committee.
